- 5. The architectural drawings in the miniature paintings.

- 7. A ground plan of any significant temple from the 10th to 14th century.
- 8. The twentieth-century archaeological photographs of the Harappan civilization.
- 9. The Great Exhibition or the Crystal Palace Exhibition, 1851.
- 10. The early modern maps of any South Asian city/town.
