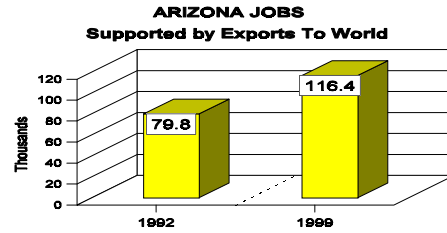
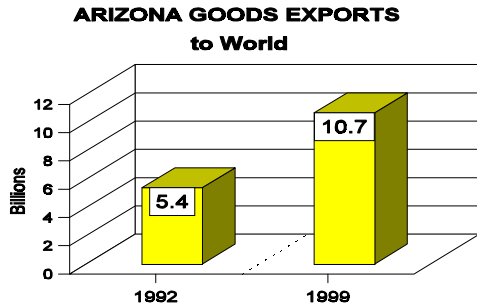


ARIZONA STATE EXPORTS



- # In 1999, Arizona's goods exports were \$10.7 billion, up 97 percent (\$5.3 billion) from 1992. During 1999, Arizona was the 20th largest state exporter of goods in the United States.
- # In 1999, Arizona's jobs supported by goods exports were an estimated 46 percent (36,520 jobs) higher than 1992. U.S. jobs supported by goods exports pay 13 to 16 percent higher than the national average wage.
- # In 1991, the latest year available, Arizona's exports accounted for 23.0 percent of its manufacturing output and represented 20.8 percent of its total manufacturing employment.
- # Arizona's exports of manufactured products were up by 75 percent between 1993 and 1999 (from \$5.8 billion in 1993 to \$10.2 billion in 1999).
- # The five largest manufacturing sectors in terms of Arizona's exports were: Electronic and Electric Equipment (\$4.9 billion of exports in 1999), Transportation Equipment (\$1.6 billion), Industrial Machinery and Computers (\$1.2 billion), Scientific and Measuring Instruments (\$607.5 million), and Fabricated Metal Products (\$368.9 million). These five sectors accounted for over 81 percent of the state's total exports in 1999.
- # Among Arizona's fastest growing manufactured exports (in millions) were:

- # Arizona is the country's 32nd largest agricultural exporting state, shipping \$333 million in agricultural exports abroad in FY 1999. The two largest export categories, vegetables, and cotton and linters, accounted for 42 percent of Arizona's agricultural exports in FY 1999.
- # Total exports from Arizona to NAFTA countries in 1999 were 100 percent higher than 1993 (pre-NAFTA), rising from \$1.8 billion in 1993 to \$3.7 billion in 1999. During 1999, Canada was Arizona's second largest export market, while Mexico was Arizona's largest export market. Exports to Canada in 1999 were 80 percent (\$558.5 million) higher than 1993, to \$1.3 billion in 1999. Exports to Mexico in 1999 were 112 percent (\$1.3 billion) higher than 1993, to \$2.4 billion in 1999.
- # In 1999, total exports from Arizona to Japan were 19.2 percent (\$132.8 million) higher than 1993, to \$824.8 million in 1999. During 1999, Japan was Arizona's fourth largest export market.
- # In 1999, total exports from Arizona to the European Union were 31 percent (\$504 million) higher than 1993, to \$2.2 billion in 1999.
- # In 1999, Arizona exported \$384.8 million to South/Central America and the Caribbean (excluding Mexico), \$2.9 billion to the Pacific Rim (excluding Japan and China) and \$9.0 million to SubSaharan Africa.
- # In 1999, Arizona exported \$173.1 million to China, its 13th largest export market.
