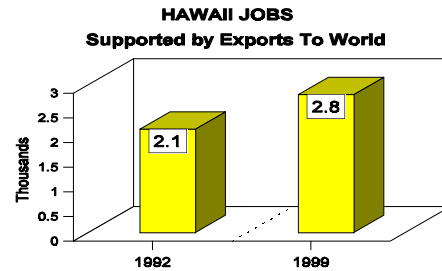
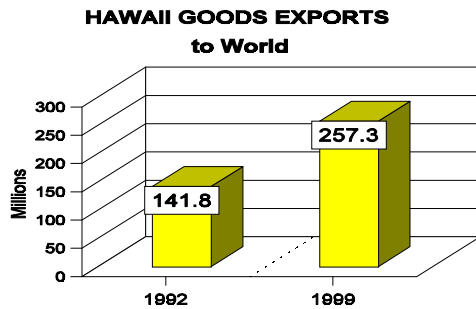


HAWAII STATE EXPORTS



- # In 1999, Hawaii's goods exports were running at a rate of \$257.3 million, up 82 percent (\$116 million) from 1992. During 1999, Hawaii was the second smallest state exporter of goods.
- # In 1999, Hawaii's jobs supported by goods exports were an estimated 34 percent (712 jobs) higher than 1992. U.S. jobs supported by goods exports pay 13 to 16 percent higher than the national average wage.
- # In 1991, the latest year available, Hawaii's exports accounted for 16.3 percent of its manufacturing output and represented 14.0 percent of its total manufacturing employment.
- # Hawaii's exports of manufactured products were up by 15 percent between 1993 and 1999 (from \$181.6 million in 1993 to \$209.0 million in 1999).
- # The five largest manufacturing sectors in terms of Hawaii's exports were: Petroleum and Coal Products (\$50.5 million of exports in 1999), Scientific and Measuring Instruments (\$30.1 million), Transportation Equipment (\$28.3 million), Food Products (\$25.0 million), and Miscellaneous Manufacturing (\$18.4 million). These five sectors accounted for 59 percent of the state's total exports in 1999.
- # Among Hawaii fastest growing manufactured exports (in millions) were:

- # Hawaii is the country's 38th largest agricultural exporting state, shipping \$108 million in agricultural exports abroad in FY 1999. The largest export category, fruits, accounted for half of Hawaii's agricultural exports in FY 1999.
- # Total exports from Hawaii to NAFTA countries in 1999 were 26 percent higher than 1993 levels (pre-NAFTA), rising from \$19.1 million in 1993 to \$23.9 million in 1999. During 1999, Canada was Hawaii's second largest export market, while Mexico was Hawaii's 20th largest export market. Exports to Canada in 1999 were 24 percent (\$4.5 million) higher than 1993, to \$23.1 million in 1999. Exports to Mexico in 1999 were 102 percent (\$417 million) higher than 1993, to \$825 million in 1999.
- # In 1999, total exports from Hawaii to Japan were 41 percent (\$41.2 million) higher than 1993, to \$141.0 million in 1999. During 1999, Japan was Hawaii's largest export market.
- # In 1999 total exports from Hawaii to the European Union were 45 percent (\$3.8 million) higher than 1993, to \$12.3 million in 1999.
- # In 1999, Hawaii exported \$1.9 million to South/Central America and the Caribbean (excluding Mexico), \$53.7 million to the Pacific Rim (excluding Japan and China) and \$434 thousand to SubSaharan Africa.
- # In 1999, Hawaii exported \$1.5 million to China, its 15th largest export market.
